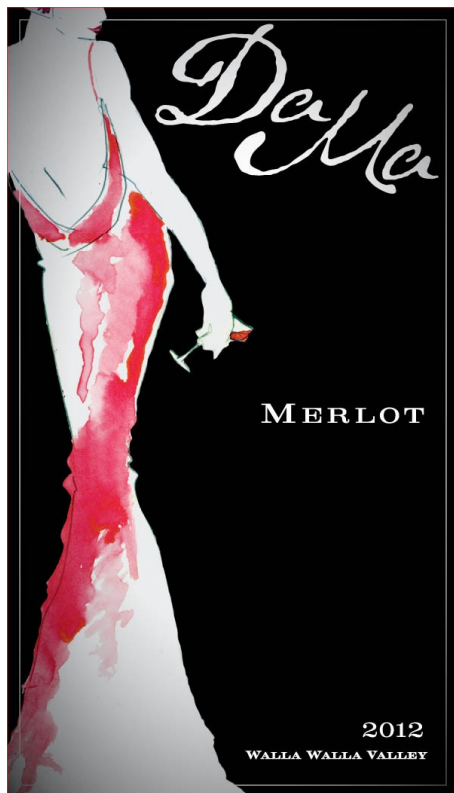


2012 Merlot
